## **Guidelines for Research Paper Submission:**

- The Research Paper should be related to the domain of the book chapter.
- ➤ Papers must be Original, plagiarism-free, with proper citation, unpublished and currently not submitted for publication elsewhere.
- ➤ The first page should include the title, name of the author(s), affiliation, telephone number and email address.
- ➤ Papers should be within the page count of about 15-20 pages and words ranging between 7,000-10,000 inclusive of abstract and references.
- ➤ Paper contributions should have an abstract (within 300 words) with keywords (minimum 3 to maximum 5). A maximum of 4 Authors per Paper is expected.
- ➤ All manuscripts should be submitted only in MS Word file: Times New Roman with font size of 12 and 1.5-line spacing with references at the end of the research paper in IEEE referencing style.
- For case-based primary source research, consent/clearance to publish the case will be required from the company/organization/individual.
- ➤ A Similarity score of 15% or lower is considered acceptable for all the papers.
- Chapter should include all the figures and tables captioned properly.
- ➤ If you have not drawn the figure, then please take the permission from the respective author. Figures should be of clear quality with high resolution and numbered consecutively e.g. Fig. 1, Fig. 2
- ➤ Tables should be numbered consecutively e.g. Table 1, Table 2 etc. Figures and tables should be aligned at the center, separately numbered, and self-explained. The table titles must be above the table, and data sources should be mentioned below the table. The authors should ensure that tables and figures are appropriately referenced.
- ➤ No AI or ChatGPT content to be used while preparing the chapters.
- ➤ The papers accepted will be double-blind, peer-reviewed, and evaluated based on and relevance to the book chapters.
- ➤ All the accepted papers will be checked once again in Turnitin, and the report will be generated; if is more than 15% the paper will be rejected.
